Joining the program

- **New patients** must **complete** comprehensive exam, full series of x-rays, **recommended** cleaning, and next continuing care appointment.
- **Current patients** must be on-schedule with their continuing care hygiene appointments: two most recent continuing care appointments completed on-schedule.
- All patients must complete treatment necessary for bleaching.

Program rules

- Non-transferrable
- One (1) tube of bleach dispensed every six (6) months at the conclusion of regular continuing care appointment (therefore a maximum two (2) tubes per twelve (12) months).
- Must remain current with continuing care appointments:
 - Patients must adhere to the treatment & cleaning schedule recommended.
 - Broken appointments must be scheduled and completed within two (2) weeks of the original appointment date. Appointments rescheduled or cancelled with less than 48 hours of notice are considered broken.
- No outstanding balance.
- May not have more than one broken appointment within the previous twelve (12) months.
- Lost or destroyed whitening trays will be replaced at patient's expense.

Please note:
